- •Kumtor (Kyrgystan) Training, small scale village-based projects, local health facilities, models of best-practice
- •Ranger, Osborne, Granny Smith (Australia) Training, employment & mentoring of aboriginals, promotion of intercultural awareness, aboriginal heritage research

Community Integration & Impact Minimisation Programs

- Early Discussion with local community reps
- Ongoing dialogue
- Identify areas of interest for joint projects
- Establish a Community Steering Committee
- Involve as many as possible in the projects
- Funding issues
- Develop & implement a Sustainable Community
 Plan
