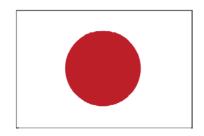

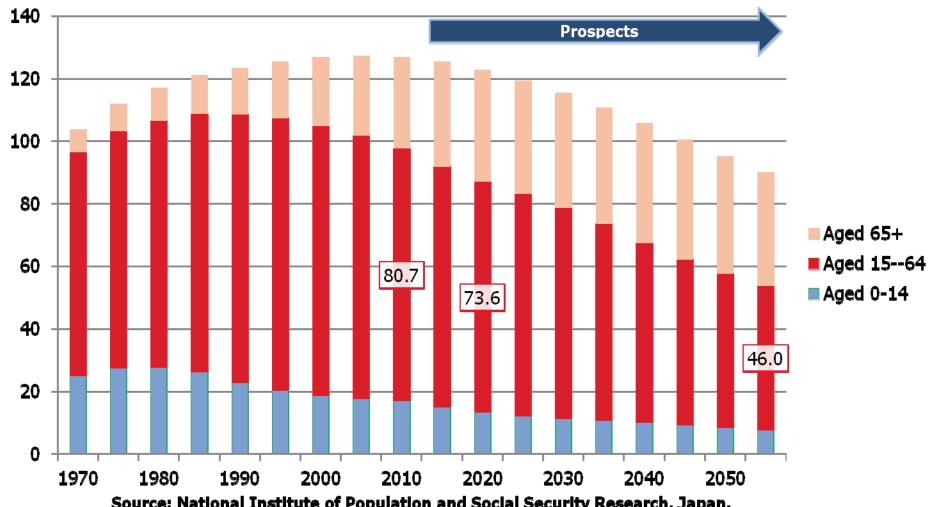

1. Our Inevitable Future: Shrinking Population

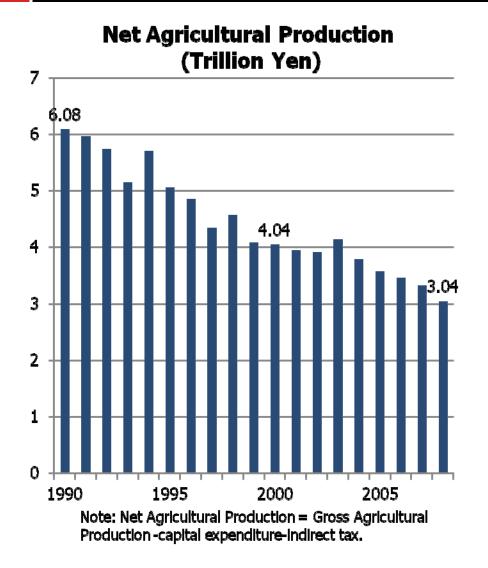
Japan's Population Prospects (Median variant, Millions)

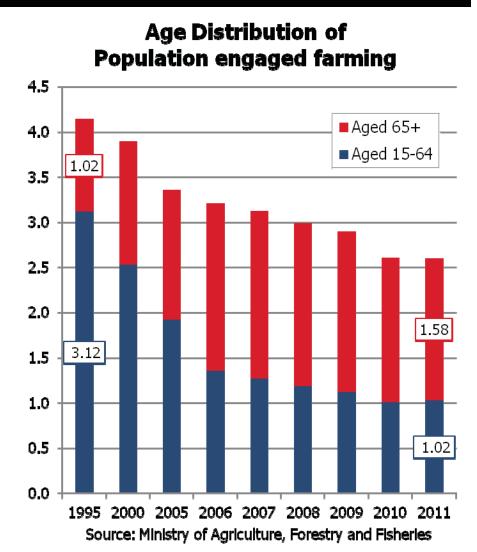

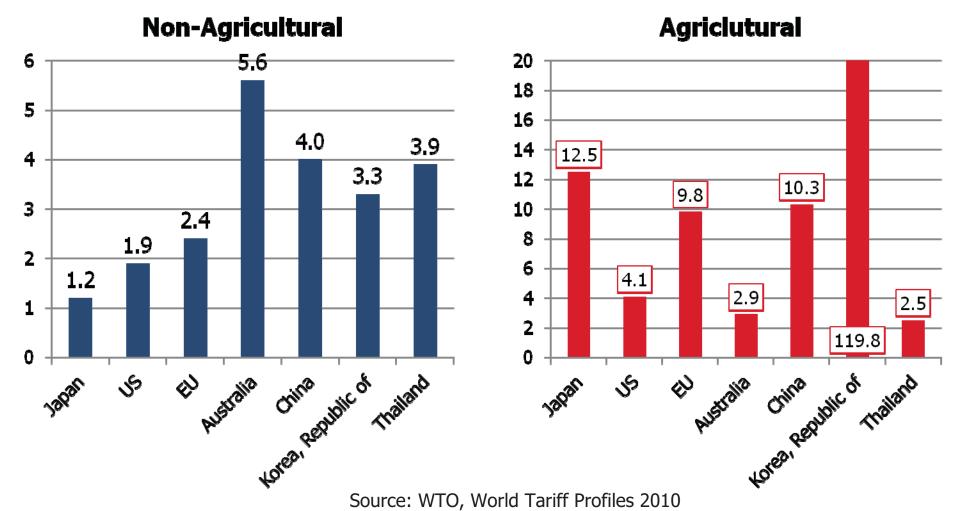






3. Japan's tariff: Big Gap between industrial and agricultural

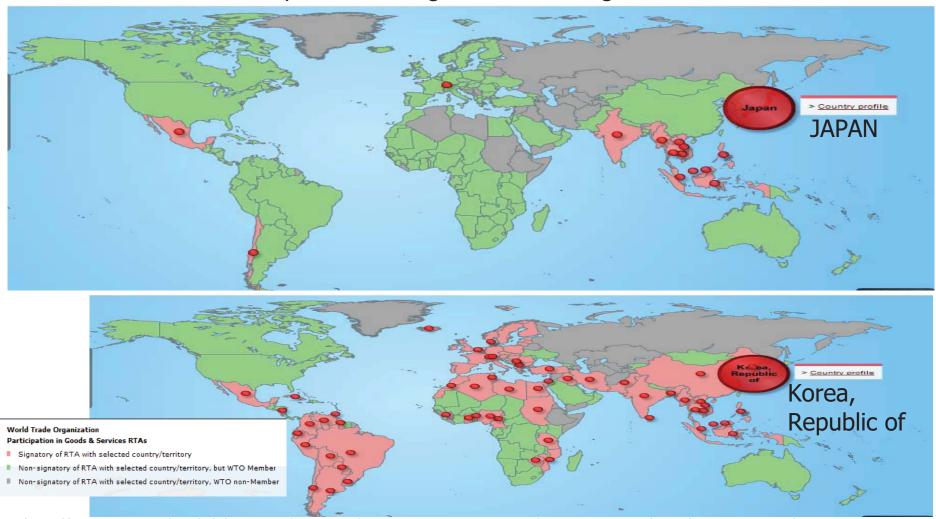
Tariff Rates (Trade weighted average)
